Project Title: Willow Slough Bypass North Levee Pipe Removal and Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0217-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Willow Slough Bypass, in the County of Yolo, State of California; Latitude 38.590612, Longitude -121.721689.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0217-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Water Resources, as represented by Mitra Emami.

The Willow Slough Bypass North Levee Pipe Removal and Replacement Project consists of the excavation, removal, and replacement of a 24-inch corrugated metal culvert. After completion of the culvert replacement, the County Road, 28H, will be replaced and repaved, any temporary fill and construction debris will be removed, and disturbed areas will be planted with native grass seed.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
