Project Title: Oak Tree Lane Road Widening and Extension Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2016-0130-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at North Ingram Slough, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 38.886519, Longitude -121.268779.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) previously executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2016-0130-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Lincoln. Project construction was delayed, and the Applicant requested to extend the Agreement term pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1605(b). CDFW is extending the Agreement term an additional five years, expiring February 13, 2027.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement extension on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
