Title: Ghori (Summer Brook) Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0212-R2)

Project Location: North side of Green Valley Road 500 feet west of the intersection with Bass Lake Road in Cameron Park, El Dorado County at approximately -121.022098, 38.698789.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed a Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0212-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Amar Ghori.

The Project is limited to the grading and filling of a total of 0.07 aquatic resources. These activities include, installation of twin 30” culverts in irrigated wetland, installation of two 36” culverts through an intermittent drainage, installation of an 18” culvert in a canal, and widening Green Valley Road in irrigated wetland.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
