**Project Title:** Shinn Ranch (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-ELD-20872-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at Slate Creek, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; Latitude 38.67510, Longitude -120.87240; South of Mother Lode Road and east of Kingvale Road in Placerville, CA 95667; Assessor's Parcel Numbers: 331-620-004-000, 331-620-005-000, 331-620-013-000, 331-620-030-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-ELD-20872-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Thomas Shinn.

The project is limited to the installation of four (4) High Density Polyethylene (HDPE) storm drainpipes culverts:

- A 125 linear foot, 24-inch diameter culvert situated at the outflow from the unnamed pond at the road crossing near the Channel 5 dam. The culvert will include creation of a concrete and rock flow dissipater.
- A 175 linear foot, 30-inch diameter culvert located on the main seasonal drainage where it enters Slate Creek. The outflow of the culvert will include a concrete and rock flow dissipater. The culvert crossing will facilitate road construction near Open Space Lot D.
- A 15 linear foot, 30-inch diameter culvert on the main seasonal drainage tributary to Slate Creek. The outflow of the culvert will include a concrete and rock flow dissipater. The culvert crossing will be located under a recreational trail near Lot 118.
- A 30 linear foot, 30-inch diameter culvert on the main seasonal drainage tributary to Slate Creek. The outflow of the culvert will include a concrete and rock flow dissipater. The culvert crossing will be under an access road to Open Space Lot G.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
