PROJECT LOCATION: Located at the southwest corner of Leslie Street and Centennial Street in the unincorporated town of Los Alamos, Santa Barbara County. Project site is within Ferrini Park, owned by Los Alamos Community Services District (LACSD) and addressed as 175 Bell Street, Los Alamos.


PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), as the responsible agency, will be issuing a water supply permit. The LACSD proposed project involves the drilling of a groundwater well and constructing of a pump house, onsite treatment facilities, security fencing, landscaping, and pipelines to connect to the existing LACSD water delivery and sewer systems. Construction of the project will encompass approximately 816 square feet of Ferrini Park. The well will be drilled to a maximum depth of 1,000 feet below ground surface and will produce between 800 to 1,000 gallons per minute of water from the San Antonio Creek Valley Groundwater Basin. The project would also include a water waste line, including dechlorination and an air gap. Treatment chemicals will be stored near the well pump house and will be surrounded by a secondary containment tank to capture any potential spills or leaks. Security fencing will consist of an eight-foot-high concrete block wall and will be surrounded by a landscape buffer. The proposed project will supplement lost water production due to aging well casings and equipment from the existing LACSD Well No. 4.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: This is to advise that the State Water Board has issued a water supply permit 4210002PA-001 for the above described project on March 7, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have significant effects on the environment.
2. A Negative Declaration was prepared for this project pursuant to the provision of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the issuance of this permit.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was adopted for this project.
5. Findings were made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
6. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted for this project.

This is to certify that the record of permit issuance for the project is available to the general public at the State Water Board Division of Drinking Water District office noted above. The Mitigated Negative Declaration is available from the lead agency.

The State Water Board is a responsible agency for this project and is not responsible for the Department of Fish and Wildlife filing fees.
