Project Title: Tonev Stream Crossings and Stream Restoration Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0715-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Connick Creek watershed, approximately 2.5 miles west southwest of the town of Garberville, County of Humboldt, State of California; Section 27, T4S, R3E, Humboldt Base and Meridian, in the Garberville U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 222-092-001; latitude/longitude 40.0903, -123.8411 at the stream restoration project.

Project Description: The project is limited to three (3) encroachments. Two encroachments are to decommission unarmored ford crossings on an abandoned skid trail. One (1) encroachment is to conduct stream restoration and revegetation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
