Project Title: Koger Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-16611-R1)

Project Location: The project is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 1 mile southwest of the town of Petrolia, County of Humboldt, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Number 105-041-006.

Project Description: The project is limited to two (2) encroachments to upgrade failing stream crossings and rehabilitate. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the failing crossings, replacement with new properly designed crossings, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Permittee shall revegetate the areas above and below the crossings with plantings of native willow and cottonwood trees.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
