Project Title: Massaro Stream Crossing Projects (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-51132-R1)


Project Location: The Project to be completed is located within the Bear Creek - Mad River watershed, approximately 1.4 miles north of the town of Dinsmore, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 33, T02N, R05E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Blake Mountain U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 208-251-006-000; latitude 40.5112 N and longitude 123.6138 W at the first stream crossing.

Project Description: The Project is limited to three encroachments. The three proposed encroachments are to upgrade existing culverts or upgrade crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. Bank slopes that are restored shall be pulled back at no greater than 2:1. Slopes shall be seeded and stabilized.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21081, subdivision (a).
