Project Title: Borissov Stream Crossing Projects (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-50326-R1C)

Project Location: The Project to be completed is located within the Upper Larabee Creek watershed, approximately 2.4 miles northwest of the town of Blocksburg, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 13, T02S, R04E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Blocksburg U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 217-411-013-000; latitude 40.2929 N and longitude 123.6747 W at the first crossing.

Project Description: The Project is limited to four encroachments to upgrade/improve existing culverts at road/stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include maintenance with hands tools, excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. SC-4 will require pulling back the downstream banks for approximately 30' to no greater than 2:1. These shall be revegetated through seeding and covered with straw to minimize any erosion.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Lead Agency / a Responsible Agency approved the above-described project and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
