Title: Water Recycling Facility & River Access Improvement EIR Outfall Relocation Addendum

Applicant: City of Petaluma

Location: Sovereign land in the Petaluma River, adjacent to Assessor's Parcel Number 068-010-024 in Sonoma County

Description: The City will relocate the existing ECWRF Petaluma River outfall structure to the tidal slough within and adjacent to the southern corner of the ECWR Facility. The existing Petaluma River outfall, as well as an emergency pipeline and outfall, will be removed. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 18-month General Lease – Public Agency Use through December 6, 2025.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on June 7, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the City of Petaluma (City), certified the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) and Mitigation Monitoring Program (MMP) and approved the project on August 5, 2002. On August 8, 2022, the City adopted an Addendum to the EIR and MMP to address any changes to the proposed project. The Commission considered the EIR and Addendum, as certified and adopted, respectively, for this project and adopted an independent MMP incorporating the City's documents. The EIR, Addendum, and the record of project approval may be examined at the above shown California State Lands Commission Sacramento office address.
