## RESOLUTION 19-32

### RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WEST SACRAMENTO CERTIFYING THE INITIAL STUDY/MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION, MITIGATION MONITORING PLAN AND FINDINGS OF FACT FOR THE WEST CAPITOL AVENUE ROAD REHABILITATION AND SAFETY ENHANCEMENT PROJECT

**WHEREAS**, on November 16, 2016, the City Council adopted the General Plan 2035 Update; and

**WHEREAS**, a Streetscape Master Plan prepared in 2007 identified Improvements to West Capitol Avenue, on July 18, 2018, the City Council adopted the 2018 Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2018 Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan identifies West Capitol Avenue as a Signature Bikeway Project for City of West Sacramento ("City"); Amendment to the 2018-19 CIP budget includes funding for the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project.

**WHEREAS**, the City proposes to rehabilitate pavement, improve pedestrian crossings, add lighting, add bike lanes; and

**WHEREAS**, construction of the improvements will improve safety and mobility for pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles; and

**WHEREAS**, the project is in furtherance of the goals and recommendations contained within the 2018 Bicycle, Pedestrian, and Trails Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the City conducted the required tribal consultations pursuant to AB52 as part of the environmental review process for the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project.

**WHEREAS**, the City circulated a draft Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) addressing the potential impacts of the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project for 30 days starting in February 20, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has prepared an Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration in accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, CEQA Guidelines, and all other applicable laws and regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, the City has considered all public comments received on the Mitigated Negative Declaration and that adequate mitigation will be applied to the project; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the public health, safety and general welfare warrant the adoption of the Mitigation Monitoring Plan for the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council has reviewed the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project final Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration and finds that the public health, safety and general welfare warrant the certification of the final IS/MND.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of West Sacramento finds that:

- 1) The West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project Initial Study and Mitigated Negative Declaration has been completed in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act; and

- 2) Section 3.0 of the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project final IS/MND and Mitigation Monitoring Plan has identified several "Potentially Significant Impacts". All impacts will be mitigated to "Less Than Significant" through identified mitigation measures; and,
- 3) The West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project final IS/MND has been reviewed and considered by the City Council prior to any action by the City Council on the Project; and
- 4) The West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project final IS/MND reflects the City of West Sacramento's independent judgment and analysis; and
- 5) The City Council of the City of West Sacramento has considered and hereby adopts the Findings and Statements of the final IS/MND and Mitigation Monitoring Plan for the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project and
- 6) The City Council hereby certifies the West Capitol Avenue Road Rehabilitation and Safety Enhancement Project final IS/MND.


