
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0377-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Mountain House Developers, LLC.

The project is limited to construction of a 1.5-acre outfall pond between Mountain House Creek and Lake K within a 2.69-acre project area.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on May 19, 2021, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
