Description of Previous Action/Project:



- (3) New information of substantial importance, which was not known and could not have been known with the exercise of reasonable diligence at the time the previous EIR was certified, shows any of the following:
 - a. The project will have one or more significant effects not discussed in the previous EIR
 - b. Significant effects previously examined will be substantially more severe than shown in the previous EIR
 - c. Mitigation measures or alternatives previously found not to be feasible would in fact be feasible, and would substantially reduce one or more significant effects of the project, but the project proponents decline to adopt the mitigation measure or alternative; or,
 - d. Mitigation measures or alternatives which are considerably different from those analyzed in the previous EIR would substantially reduce one or more significant effects on the environment, but the project proponents decline to adopt the mitigation measure or alternative.

Brief Project Description: The Lost Abbey (A Craft Brewery) recently took over a historic Mexican Presbyterian Church located at 1313 J Street in East Village San Diego. This was an existing building. There is no brewing located on site. Operating a duplicate type 23 license for Satellite tasting room. Applicant applied for a conditional use permit with the City of San Diego for offsite to go beer sales.
