Thank you for including the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in the review process for the above-referenced project.

The proposed Project would involve replacement of the existing grass field and paved basketball courts with a joint use, multi-purpose, synthetic, all-weather sports field with football, soccer, and lacrosse markings, a five-lane, all-weather jogging track, fitness equipment, perimeter security fence with privacy screening, restroom and storage/maintenance building(s), walkways, landscaping, irrigation, re-grading of the existing basketball court surface, and sports field lighting. The proposed Project would make use of existing street and on-site parking. No change in site access or parking would occur.

The nearest State facility to the proposed project is SR-134. After reviewing the DEIR, Caltrans does not anticipate any significant adverse impacts to the State Highway System.

As a reminder, transportation of heavy construction equipment and/or materials, which requires the use of oversized-transport vehicles on State highways, will require a Caltrans transportation permit. Caltrans recommends that large size truck trips be limited to off-peak commute periods.
