Project Title: Tisdale Road Bridge Replacement (California Endangered Species Act Incidental Take Permit (ITP) No. 2081-2020-003-02) Amendment 1

Project Location: This Project is located in the Westside Canal, off Tisdale Road, in the County of Sutter, State of California, Latitude 39.023924, Longitude -121.816061.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) is approving an Amendment to the ITP that includes an update to the Principal Officer's title and agency name, a reduction in the permanent and temporary impacts to GGS habitat, and an update to the corresponding mitigation and cost estimates.

The project will result in the permanent loss of 0.13-acres and temporary loss of 0.03-acres of giant garter snake (*Thamnophis gigas*) habitat. The Project is expected to result in incidental take of giant garter snake which is designated as a threatened species under the California Endangered Species Act. The ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of species listed under CESA that may occur as a result of Project implementation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a responsible agency executed the above-described ITP Amendment on the date signed below and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a responsible agency.
2. An environmental impact report / A mitigated negative declaration was prepared by the lead agency for the original project.
3. Additional mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
