Project Title: Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement for 2501 Jonata Park Road-San Antonio Ranch, EPIMS-07682-R5.

Project Location: The project is located at 2051 Jonata Park Road, Buellton, 93427, in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 099-640-001 and 099-640-003; Latitude 34.658410, Longitude -120.184430. A tributary to Zaca Creek runs between cultivation and remediation areas.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-07682-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Maria McGee. The project is limited to the cultivation of cannabis, using only natural light. As part of the cultivation operation, the maintenance of one stream crossing, usage of a well, and the remediation of violations of Fish and Game Code will take place.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 2 / 19 / 2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
