Project Title: Restoration Activities at 705 Mail Road
(Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2020-0008-R5)

Project Location: The project is located at 705 Mail Road, Buellton, CA 93436; Assessor's Parcel Numbers 099-210-055. A tributary to the Santa Ynez River runs through the parcel.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2020-0008-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Art Olowski. The project is limited to the remediation of violations of Fish and Game Code that took place due to the illegal cultivation of cannabis. Remediation shall consist of the implementation of a restoration plan for 0.86 acre of annual brome grassland and California sagebrush scrub.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 8/18/2021 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
