Project Location: The project is located at a crossing of Asphaltum Creek, in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California; 7300 Foxen Canyon Road, Santa Maria, CA, 93454; Assessor's Parcel Number 133-070-039.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-02520-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Joseph Lombardo. The project is limited to the armoring of one at grade crossing, as well as the cultivation of 2 acres of cannabis.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 2/25/2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
