Project Title: Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-16372-R5 for 6980 Cat Canyon Road - Moriarty Holdings, LLC

Project Location: The Project is located at 6980 Cat Canyon Road (Latitude 34.812472, Longitude -120.262247; Assessor Parcel Number (APN) 101-070-0169) and 7000 Long Canyon Road (Latitude 34.812824, Longitude -120.254436; APN 101-070-075) in Los Alamos, Santa Barbara County, California, 93440. Cat Canyon Creek runs through the southern portion of APN 101-070-069. An unnamed stream, tributary to Cat Canyon Creek runs along the eastern portion of APN 101-070-075. APN 101-070-0169 contains the cultivation areas. The road/crossing needed to access the cultivation area is within APN 101-070-075.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-16372-R5 pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Jason Moriarty. The project is the cultivation of cannabis, including installation of a reinforced concrete box culvert on an unnamed stream tributary to Cat Canyon Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 5/17/2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
