Project Location: The project is located adjacent to Arroyo Paredon Creek, in the County of Santa Barbara, State of California; 3615 Foothill Road, Carpinteria, CA, 93013; Assessor's Parcel Number 005-280-041.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SBA-28343-R5, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Autumn Shelton. The project is limited to the use of one well and the restoration of 0.52 acres (22,500 square feet) of vegetation along Arroyo Paredon Creek related to the cultivation of cannabis and associated activities within six existing greenhouses and one new greenhouse on a 24-acre parcel.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 8/11/2022 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will / will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
