**Project Title:** Butano Creek Camp Pedestrian Bridge Repair (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0355-R3)

**Project Location:** The project is located at Butano Creek, in the County of San Mateo; Section 20, T8S, R4W, USGS map Franklin Point, MDB&M; APN: 089-120-040; 1400 Canyon Road, Pescadero, CA 94060.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0355-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Girl Scouts of Northern California.

The project is limited to the replacement of a single span bridge crossing Butano Creek used for pedestrian and maintenance access at the Butano Creek Girl Scout Camp. The project will remove and replace the existing wood structure with a single span I-beam bridge whose abutments will be constructed using steel piles located behind the existing concrete abutments

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 5/2/2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
