Title: Low-Energy Offshore Geophysical Permit Program (OGPP) Update

Applicant: Multiple Applicants (see below at end of the Description for individual entities)

Location: Offshore waters (to 3 nautical miles) from Mexico border to Oregon border.

Description: The California State Lands Commission has statutory authority, pursuant to Public Resources Code section 6826, to issue geophysical permits in State waters to qualified permittees for the use of low energy geophysical equipment to perform geophysical surveys of the ocean bottom, subject to specified terms and conditions. The California State Lands Commission action is issuing a 3-year non-exclusive geophysical survey permits to David Evans and Associates, Incorporated (A3853), Ocean Infinity Group Limited (A3683).

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on February 28, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A  Mitigated Negative Declaration was adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
