**PROJECT LOCATION:** Ocotillo Wells SVRA: County of Imperial

**PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** A temporary waterline is necessary to provide construction water to a project at the Salton City Landfill. The temporary waterline would be placed aboveground along the southern edge of the paved traveled portion of the landfill access road as it crosses Section 6, T11S, R10E. The waterline would cross Poleline Road in Section 7, T11S, R10E within Parks land south of the intersection landfill road (aboveground) and then cross Poleline Road where it will enter the Salton City Landfill property underground through an existing storm water drainage culvert. Issuance of a temporary access permit from Parks would allow the construction of the waterline; the larger project has been permitted by Imperial County (SCH #2010071072).
