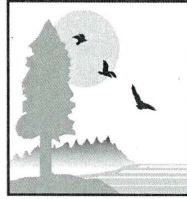

Title: Tower Bridge Fender Replacement Project

Proponent: California Department of Transportation – District 3

Location: Pier 6 and Pier 7 of the Tower Bridge (Bridge No. 22-0021) located on State Route (SR) 275 between the cities of West Sacramento and Sacramento, in Yolo and Sacramento counties.


Description: The project would remove and replace the fender system surrounding Pier 6 and Pier 7 of the Tower Bridge. The State Lands Commission action is an amendment of lease Right-of-Way Use for the mooring of construction equipment associated with the Tower Bridge Fender Replacement Project.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as  Lead Agency  Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on June 28, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project  will  will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A  Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was adopted for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures  were  were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was or  was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations  was  was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings  were  were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the California Department of Transportation, adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and approved the project and mitigation measures on January 8, 2016. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by the California Department of Transportation.
