Project Title: Mendocino Coast TMDL Implementation Project, Phase II, Thomas-Douglass Property, Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-MEN-34235-R1C

Project Location: The project to be completed is located within the Indian Creek watershed, approximately 4 miles northwest of the town of Boonville, County of Mendocino, State of California. The project is located in Section 15, Township 14N, Range 14W, Mt. Diablo Base and Meridian; in the Philo U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 046-550-09-00; latitude 39.068372 N and longitude 123.383382 W at the project location.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-MEN-34235-R1C, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Joseph Scriven.

The project is limited to one encroachment to upgrade an existing culvert. Work for this encroachment will include excavation, removal of the existing culvert, placement of a new properly sized culvert, backfilling and compaction of fill, rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion, and installation of a single post debris deflector upstream of the culvert.
