Project Title: Permit No. 13632-1: Pacific Gas and Electric Company – Utility Pole Relocation

Project Applicant: Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E)

Project Location/City/County: The project is located approximately 0.9 miles east of the intersection of State Route (SR) 45 and SR 162, about 0.6 miles southwest of Butte City, in Glenn County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 13632-1: To authorize an existing PG&E electric distribution line that spans the Sacramento River Overflow area near River Mile 167 for a total distance of approximately 3,000 feet. There are 13 utility poles associated with the distribution line. Four (4) of the 13 existing utility poles will be relocated to accommodate replacement of the Caltrans Highway 162 Bridge over the Sacramento River (Br. No. 11-0017). The electric distribution line being permitted is a segment of the existing electric distribution line that was permitted under Permit No. 13632.

This is to advise that the Central Valley Flood Protection Board, as the **Responsible Agency**, approved the above described project on 4/13/21 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
