Project Title: Permit No. 19599: Cosumnes River Bridge Replacement Project – Restoration Plan

Project Location/City/County: The project is located where State Route (SR) 99 crosses the Cosumnes River Designated Floodway (DF), approximately 1.6 miles south of the Grant Line Road Overcrossing, about 2.5 miles south of the City of Elk Grove in Sacramento County.

Project Description: Approval of Permit No. 19599, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To implement a restoration plan within the Cosumnes River Designated Floodway. The project will mitigate for impacts occurring during tree removal activity at the Cosumnes Ecological Preserve as a result of the Cosumnes River Bridge Replacement Project (Permit No. 19431.) The restoration area includes approximately eight (8) acres and the restoration work includes planting 207 valley oak trees.

This is to advise that the CVFPB, as the **Responsible Agency**, approved the above-described project on January 6, 2022 and made the following determinations regarding the above-described project:
