Title: Caltrans District 3 Cosumnes River Bridge Replacement Project

Proponent: California Department of Transportation

Location: On State Route 99 between post miles 7.1 to 9.4 near the city of Elk Grove, Sacramento County.

Description: The replacement of four bridge structures, improving the Dillard Road Overcrossing, relinquishing the McConnell Underpass, replacing the McConnell Overhead structure, realigning the southbound (SB) lanes of SR 99 and maintaining access to SB SR 99 at Eschinger Road. The Commission's action is an approval of a Public Agency Permit and approve a Right-of-Way Map as submitted by the California Department of Transportation pursuant to section 101.5 of the Streets and Highways Code and as authorized by section 6210.3 of the Public Resources Code.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, has approved the above described project on October 24, 2019, and has made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Negative Declaration (ND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were or were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) adopted the Negative Declaration (ND) and approved the project on May 20, 2019. The California State Lands Commission has considered the ND as prepared for this project by Caltrans.
