To alleviate the existing North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) violations, service projected growth, and improve reliability in the San Marcos/Escondido area, the Project includes construction new overhead single circuit power line structures, rebuilding existing structures, and reconductoring and re-energizing approximately 12 miles of a 69-kilovolt overhead electric power line from the existing San Marcos substation to the existing Escondido Substation. The Project also includes 1.2 acres of new right-of-way.
