DOCUMENT TITLE: Diamond Regional Sewer Lift Station and Dual Force Mains Project (Project)

PROJECT LOCATION: The Project is generally located east of the City of Lake Elsinore and approximately 0.7 mile southwest of Interstate 15 (I-15), in western Riverside County, California. According to the Lake Elsinore, California U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) quadrangle map, the Project site is in the unsectioned La Laguna land grant, south of East Lakeshore Drive, along Elm Street in the north and adjacent to Diamond Circle in the southern portion of the Project alignment.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as Diamond Regional Sewer Lift Station and Dual Force Mains. The Project includes The Project will construct the new Diamond Regional Sewer Lift Station in the City of Lake Elsinore. The Project will also include the installation of approximately 3,400 linear feet of dual force main pipes. The new lift station will serve as the regional wastewater lift station and will replace three existing lift stations currently in service.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on November 8, 2022. The Elsinore Valley Municipal Water District will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted/certified for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting program was adopted for the Project.
