Project Location (include county): The State Route (SR) 62, Embankment Restoration Project, post mile (PM) 124-142 (termed herein as 'Project') is located on U.S. SR 62 in San Bernardino County, between 1.75 miles west of the intersection of SR 62 and SR 95 to approximately 0.6 miles west of the border with Arizona. The project area occurs within the Vidal Junction, Parker NW, and Parker, California, United States Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute series topographic quadrangles. Specifically, the project is in Township 1 North, Range 23 East, Section 08 and Township 1 North, Range 25 East, Sections 18, and 20-24. The geographic coordinates near the middle of the study area are 34.17280° North latitude and 114.38694° West longitude.

Project Description: The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes a project to construct a water downstream protection system at 10 desert wash locations. The protection system starts at the edge of traveled way and consists of a plain concrete slab for drainage purposes and a non-erodible concrete rock side slope. The approximate dimensions of the improvements are 200 feet long by 80 feet wide. Additionally, rumble strips will be installed along the concrete slab mentioned above to alert arrant vehicles against running off the road.
