Project Title: Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation Fire Access Road (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2019-0083-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project site is located off County Road 78 in the City of Brooks in the County of Yolo, State of California, Latitude 38.742221, Longitude -122.169720, Section 2, Township 10N, Range 03W of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5 quad Brooks.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0083-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Yocha Dehe Wintun Nation.

The project consists of a 24-foot wide gravel road to allow emergency vehicle access to the Tribe's properties and reduce wildfire risk. The road is planned to cross two natural drainages with culverts with inflow and outflow protection. The larger of the two drainages will be crossed with a concrete box culvert, while the smaller drainage will have a 36-inch rubber gasketed reinforced concrete pipe.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 06/12/2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
