**Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:**

The purpose of the proposed project is to construct, operate and maintain the Tisdale Weir Rehabilitation and Fish Passage Project which would integrate structural rehabilitation of the Tisdale Weir along with installation of fish passage facilities to reduce fish stranding at the weir by improving fish passage through the weir to the Sacramento River.
