Title: Tisdale Wier Rehabilitation and Fish Passage Project

Applicant: California Department of Water Resources

Location: Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent Assessor's Parcel Number 021-100-008, near Meridian, Sutter County.

Description: The Tisdale Weir Rehabilitation and Fish Passage Project would integrate structural rehabilitation of the Tisdale Weir along with installation of fish passage facilities to allow upstream migrating fish access to the Sacramento River. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 5-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through December 16, 2029, to install a temporary cofferdam.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on December 17, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) An Environmental Impact Report (EIR) was prepared pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the Project, the California Department of Water Resources (DWR), certified the EIR and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the Project on October 13, 2021. The California State Lands Commission has considered the EIR as prepared for this Project by DWR and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating DWR's document.
