Description of Project:

The City of Redding proposes an improvement project on Airport Road in Redding. The purpose of the project is to improve cyclist and motorist safety by providing paved shoulders for cyclists and turn lanes for motorists. These improvements would require road widening, earthwork, drainage modification, vegetation removal, utility relocation, paving, guardrail replacement, sign installation, and striping. Temporary construction easements will be required, and disposal material will be taken to the City of Redding Landfill.

The contractor will be required to prepare a Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan and Best Management Practices will be implemented. The project has been reviewed for sensitive resources and will not have a significant effect on biological or cultural resources such as threatened or endangered species or their habitats, sensitive vegetation communities, tribal lands, or tribal cultural resources. The project has no potential to have a significant effect on the environment.
