Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project: The grant funds will allow Stewards of the Sierra National Forest (SoTSNF), a division of California Trail Users Coalition (CTUC), to perform routine trail and road maintenance activities on approximately 70.6 miles of routes. Activities include removing road and trail side brush; minor tread maintenance; blocking unauthorized routes; removing downed trees and boulders from roadways and trails; maintaining drainage structures such as culverts; armoring stream crossings; placing rock riprap; repairing and installing directional signs and route markers; placing retaining barriers and support structures for tread repair and stream approaches; trash removal; and road and trail condition surveys.
