**Project Title:** Citrus Heights Electric Greenway (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. SAC-14633-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located at two locations at Arcade Creek and Cripple Creek in the City of Citrus Heights, in the County of Sacramento, State of California. The Arcade Creek portion of the project is located within Sundance Park, east of Fair Oaks at 38.688348, --121.260680 on Section 30, Township 10 North, Range 7 East, Assessor's Parcel Number (APN) 259-0310-024-0000. The Cripple Creek portion of the project is located in the Woodside Oaks/Olivine Drive Open Space Site, north of Olivine Drive and west of Wachtel Way at 38.707885, -121.248210 on Section 19, Township 10 North, Range 7 East. The project area occurs on two parcels: APN 224-0162-031-0000 and 224-0620-001-0000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement No. SAC-14633-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the City of Citrus Heights, as represented by Casey Kempenaar.

The project is limited to the replacement of an existing pedestrian trail bridge and installation of two pedestrian trail crossings as a part of the larger Citrus Heights Electric Greenway Project : the Arcade Creek crossing will replace an existing pedestrian bridge, the Arcade Creek tributary crossing will install a new culvert pedestrian crossing, and the Cripple Creek crossing will install a new pedestrian bridge.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan  was /  was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
