**Project Location (San Bernardino):** The Project is located within Lenwood Channel tributary to the Mojave River, in the County of San Bernardino, State of California; Latitude 34.863764, Longitude -117.109116; The project is located west of Interstate 15 freeway, southeast of National Trails Highway, and south of Lenwood Road in City of Barstow.


**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS- SBR-22132-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, San Bernardino County Flood Control District, represented by Anthony Pham.

The Project involves replacing the existing spillway and constructing a new flume. The damaged wire and metal revetment will be removed, and the channel will be reconfigured as an earthen trapezoidal channel.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on April 20, 2023, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
