Project Description: CDFW is intending to execute a Streambed Alteration Agreement pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code (# EPIMS-SDO-15936-R5) to the project applicant, Caltrans District 11. The project proposes to repair and rehabilitate thirteen existing culverts.
