Project Title: Plumas County Public Works Routine Maintenance Agreement (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. 1600-2019-0266-R2)

Project Location: The project is located within the boundaries of Plumas County, covering approximately 2,613 square miles. The project occurs at approximately 175 locations throughout the county, generally within or adjacent to county roads

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2019-0266-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Plumas County Department of Public Works.

The project consists of routine maintenance of drainage facilities and water crossings at approximately 175 locations throughout Plumas County, generally within or adjacent to county roads

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
