

CONSOLIDATED IRRIGATION DISTRICTNOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION
FOR THE ADAMS AND ACADEMY BASIN PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Consolidated Irrigation District (CID) plans to adopt a mitigated negative declaration for the Adams and Academy Basin Project. The public hearing will be held by the District's Board of Directors on Wednesday July 10, 2019 at 1:00pm, at the District Office, 2255 Chandler Street, Selma, CA 93662.

The project is to construct a 60-acre groundwater recharge basin by Mill Ditch and the Kingsburg Branch for CID. Monitoring wells and recovery wells are part of the project. The project location is at the SW corner of Adams and Academy Avenues, north of Parlier and south of Sanger in Fresno County. APN Nos. 353-030-64ST, 353-030-65T, 353-030-06T, 353-030-07T, 353-030-058S.

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared, describing the degree of potential environmental impacts of the proposed project. The District has assessed the potential environmental impacts of this proposed project and has determined that they will be less than significant with mitigation. Copies of the Initial Study and proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration are on file and available for public review at the District Office, 2255 Chandler Street, Selma, CA 93662. The public review period during which the District will receive comments on the proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration will begin on June 7, 2019 and end on July 8, 2019.
