
Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS- MON-39383-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the Transportation Agency for Monterey County.

The Project includes activities related to the construction of a section of a paved multi-use trail.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on
 5/22/2024 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California
 Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
