Subject: The Loma Prieta Joint Union School District (District) is releasing a Draft Initial Study and Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for Loma Prieta School Domestic Water Supply Project (Project) for review and comment to all applicable agencies, organizations and interested persons. Reviewers should focus on the content and accuracy of the Draft IS/MND in discussing potential impacts upon the environment. This Notice of Intent to Adopt a Draft IS/MND is in compliance with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). The Draft IS/MND is being circulated for a 30-day review period. Persons responding are urged to submit their comments in writing. Written comments should be delivered to the District's office, at the address listed below, by **no later than 4:30 p.m. on July 17, 2019**. Submittal of written comments via e-mail (Microsoft Word format) is also acceptable.

Project Description: The current domestic water supply system serving the schools and administrative offices at the District's Loma Prieta Campus at 23800 Summit Road are inadequate in terms of both quantity and quality. The proposed project would construct up to three wells and 1100 linear feet of pipeline would be constructed to serve the Loma Prieta School District's campus. Three potential locations for new wells have been identified near or on the School campus based on local hydrogeologic conditions. The project would drill and test wells at these three locations. Wells would be up to 250 feet deep. The proposed pipeline would extend from the wells across Summit Road (over the roadway on the underside of the existing pedestrian bridge) and connect to the school's existing water supply system.

Project and CEQA Public Hearing Date: A public meeting date for the public to review the project has been scheduled for July 26, 2019, time and location to be determined. Please check the District's website to confirm meeting time, date and location.

CEQA Project Status: A Draft IS/MND has been prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA. The Draft IS/MND prepared for this project demonstrates that *the proposed project will not have any significant or unmitigatable effects on the environment*. As a result of the adoption of this document and the implementation of the proposed mitigation measures, the proposed project will not have any significant or unmitigatable effects on the environment.
