


## Lower Moffett Creek Bridge Replacement Project

NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO CEQA



## What Is Planned

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), with the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is proposing a bridge replacement project. This project will replace the Lower Moffett Creek Bridge, No. 02-0042 near the community of Fort Jones on State Route 3 (SR-3) in Siskiyou County. The purpose of the project is to provide a bridge that meets modern highway design standards, accommodates interregional transportation needs, reduces maintenance costs, and provides safety for the traveling public.

## **Notice of Availability**

Caltrans and the FHWA have prepared an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) for the Lower Moffett Creek Bridge Replacement. This notice is to inform you of the preparation of the IS/MND and of its availability for you to review. The IS/MND is being circulated for public and agency review in accordance with California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines. It is available for public review from June 21, 2019 to July 21, 2019.
