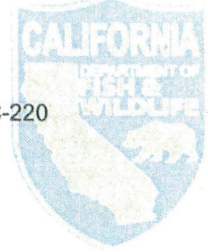

Project Title: Valley Rock & Sand (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2017-0172-R6)

Project Location (include county): The Project is located at unnamed drainages about 0.5 miles north of Airport Boulevard on the eastern side of the All American Canal, in the County of Riverside, State of California; Latitude 33.65393° N, Longitude 116.09247 W. Section 18, Township 6 South, Range 9 East, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) map Thermal Canyon, CA, San Bernardino Meridian. Assessor's Parcel Number (APN): 717-140-002.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2017-0172-R6, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, West Coast Aggregate Supply, Inc.

The Project is limited to the expansion of the adjacent surface mining of Surface Mining Permit (SMP) 129 onto the 0.8-acre adjacent area to the north for the purpose of extraction of sand, gravel, and/or rock.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on May 31, 2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
