

PROJECT LOCATION: The proposed project is located at the western edge of the Antelope Valley, directly south of the community of Mojave. The proposed project is south of State Route 58 (SR 58) and east of State Route 14 (SR 14). The site is located within Sections 22, 23, 26, 27, 35, Township 11 North, Range 12 West (SBB&M), Section 1, Township 10 North, Range 12 West (SBB&M), and Section 7, Township 10 North, Range 11 West (SBB&M).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Implementation of the project as proposed would require: a) Zone Change Case (ZCC) No. 56, Map No. 196; ZCC No. 2, Map No. 212; ZCC No. 59, Map No. 213 b) Conditional Use Permit (CUP) No. 45, Map No. 196; CUP No. 5, Map No. 212; CUP No. 66, Map No. 213; to facilitate the future construction and operation of a solar facility and associated infrastructure to generate a combined 300 megawatts of renewable electrical energy on approximately 2,102 acres of privately owned land.
