Regarding the El Dorado Irrigation District IS/MND for the Caples Lake and Silver Lake East Campground Improvements Project (# 2019069119), Caltrans District 10 has no comment at this time, other than the following:

If project construction activities will encroach into Caltrans right-of-way, the project proponent must submit an application for an encroachment permit to the Caltrans Permit Office. Appropriate environmental studies must be submitted with this application. These studies will include an analysis of potential impacts to any cultural sites, biological resources, hazardous waste locations, and/or other resources within Caltrans right-of-way at the project site(s). California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) documentation with supporting technical studies is required when submitting the encroachment permit.
