PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Campground proposes to construct a new groundwater source and replace the existing storage tank and supply piping. The Project will also provide power generation and replace portions of the distribution piping in the camp areas. Portions of the existing distribution piping will be incorporated into the new system as design models indicate suitability for use with required flows.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: This is to advise that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) has determined that the Project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act and will issue a drinking water supply permit for the operation of the above described Project. A record of permit issuance for the Project is available to the general public at the State Water Board, Division of Drinking Water District Office noted above.
