Project Location (include county): The project is located at unnamed tributaries to San Gregorio Creek, County of San Mateo, Section 22, Township 7S, Range 4W, MDB&M, USGS map La Honda, APN: 083-351-010.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number 1600-2018-0294-R3, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, William Nagle on behalf of the Carey Helen Trust Attn: Bishop Family Trust.

The project is limited to the skid trail construction at map point X2 and the permanent seasonal road construction at map points X3, X4, X5 and X6, as denoted in the approved 1-18-087 SMO "Nice" Timber Harvest Plan.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the above described project on 07/02/2019 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):
