Issue a Right of Entry permit to Caltrans to conduct a project in Jedediah Smith Redwoods State Park that would rehabilitate or replace four deteriorating culverts from post miles (PMs) 1.11 to 2.56 and improve fish passage through the Clark's Creek culvert (PM 2.56) on U.S. Highway 199 (US 199) in Del Norte County. Rehabilitation strategies include drainage system replacement using cut and cover methods, trenchless methods, and correcting deficient inlet and/or outlet conditions.
